Publication procedure of a paper proceeds through five steps:

- A. Submission
- B. Editorial Screening
- C. Review
- D. Editing
- E. Publication

The author should first register to the journal. Manuscripts of abstract and article should be submitted online at <http://www.theijmed.com/> . Upon completion of online submission, the author is expected to notify the principal administrator by email at [journals2ikm@gmail.com](mailto:journals2ikm@gmail.com) or [ayuningrum0811@gmail.com](mailto:ayuningrum0811@gmail.com).

The manuscript will then proceed through editorial screening, content review, editing, English translation if necessary, and finally publication. Accepted articles are only published online at <http://www.theijmed.com/>. If a manuscript is accepted for publication, the author will receive a Letter of Acceptance from the Executive Editor.

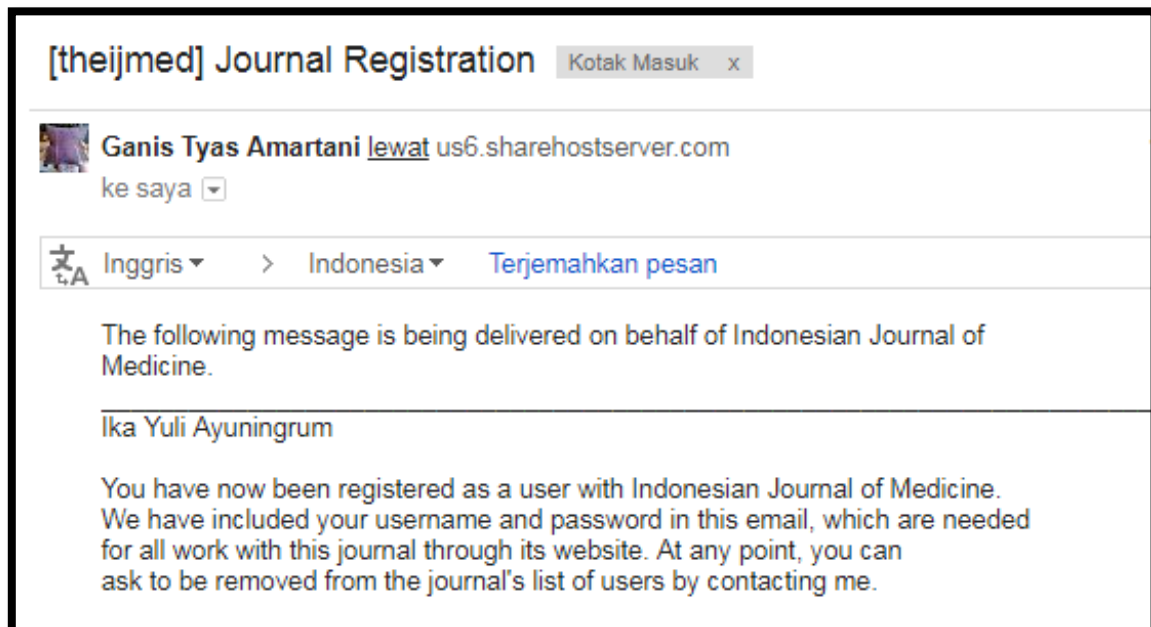

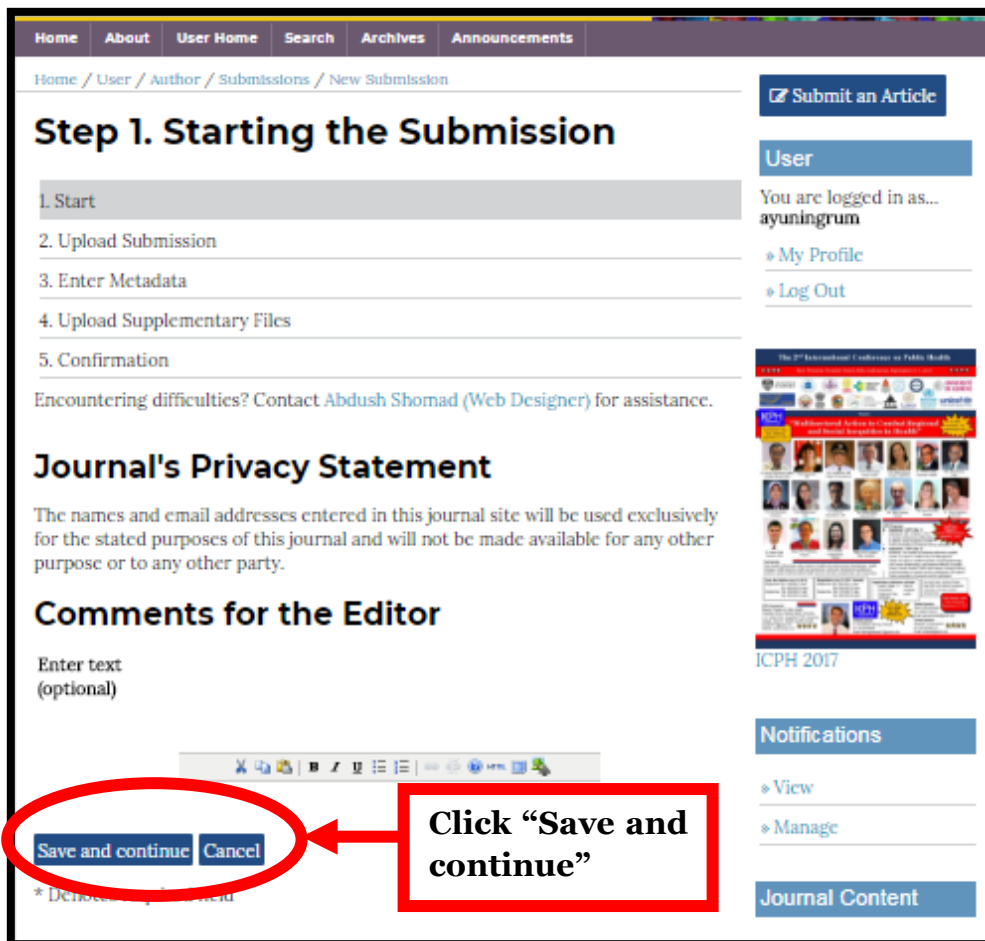



**Background:** Undernutrition by height-for-age standard starts during pregnancy and continues to the first two years of life. Linear growth disorders among children under five years are associated with morbidity, mortality, loss of physical growth potential, reduced neurological development, reduced cognitive functions, and increased risks of adulthood chronic diseases (de Onis and Branca, 2016). In 2015, the number of undernourished children under five (height-for-age) reached 156 million globally. Purworejo regency was an area with the second highest undernutrition cases in Central Java in 2014. This study aimed to analyze the life-course epidemiology perspectives on the socio-economic factors contributing to the nutritional status of the children aged two to five years in Purworejo regency, Central Java.

**Subjects and Method:** This was an observational analytical study with case control design. This study was conducted in Purworejo, Kaligesing, and Bruno sub-districts, Purworejo Regency, Central Java in February to March 2017. A total sample 160 children aged two to five years and their mothers were selected by fixed disease sampling. There were 37 children in the case groups, and 113 children in the control groups. The independent variables included family income, maternal age, maternal nutritional status (mid upper arm circumference), birth length, exclusive breastfeeding and the children’s history of illness. The dependent variable was the children’s nutritional status (MUAC (cm) (b=0.08; SE=0.05; p=0.066), birth length (cm) (b=0.22; SE=0.05; p<0.001), exclusive breastfeeding (b= 0.03; SE=0.16; p=0.080), and the absence of illness (b=0.39; SE=0.14; p=0.007).

**Results:** Nutritional status of children under five (height-for-age/HAZ) was affected by family income (x Rp 100,000) (b=0.03; SE=0.24; p<0.001), maternal age (years) (b=0.02; SE=0.02; p=0.160), maternal nutritional status/MUAC (cm) (b=0.08; SE=0.05; p=0.066), birth length (cm) (b=0.22; SE=0.05; p<0.001), exclusive breastfeeding (b= 0.03; SE=0.16; p=0.080), and the absence of illness (b=0.39; SE=0.14; p=0.007).

**Conclusion:** Nutritional status of the children under five (height-for-age/HAZ) is affected by family income, birth length, exclusive breastfeeding, maternal age, maternal nutritional status, and the absence of illness.

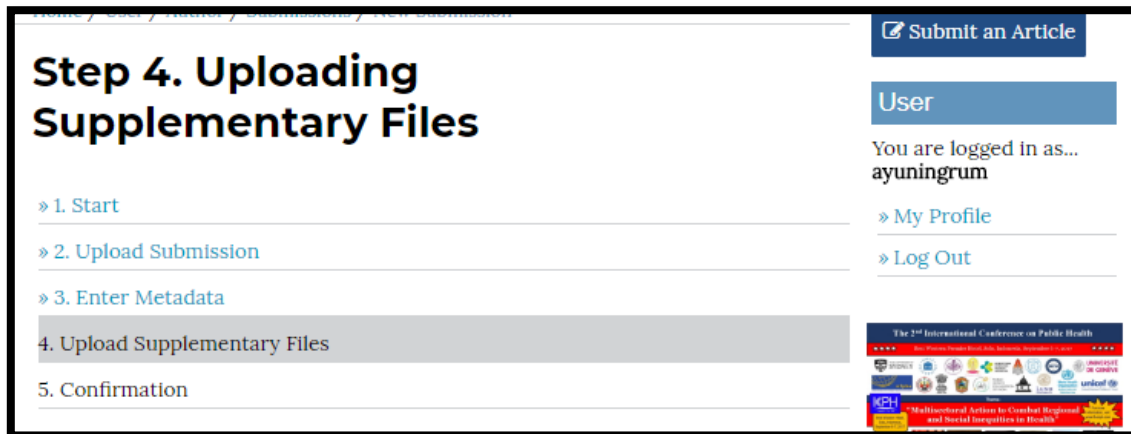

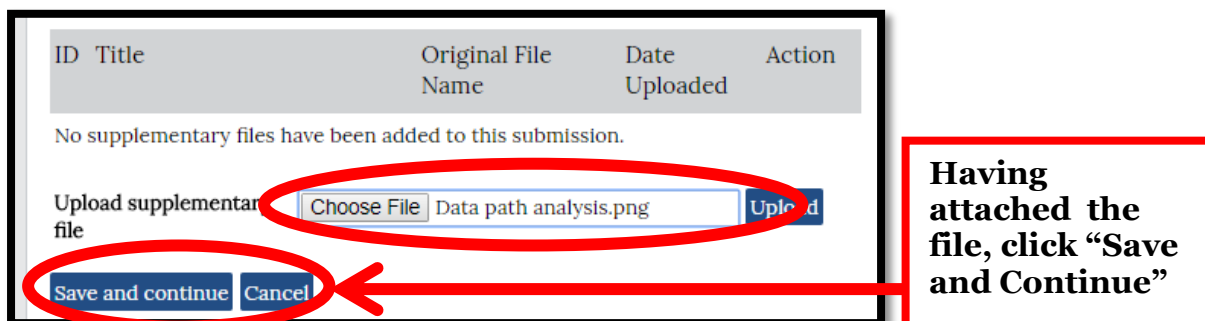

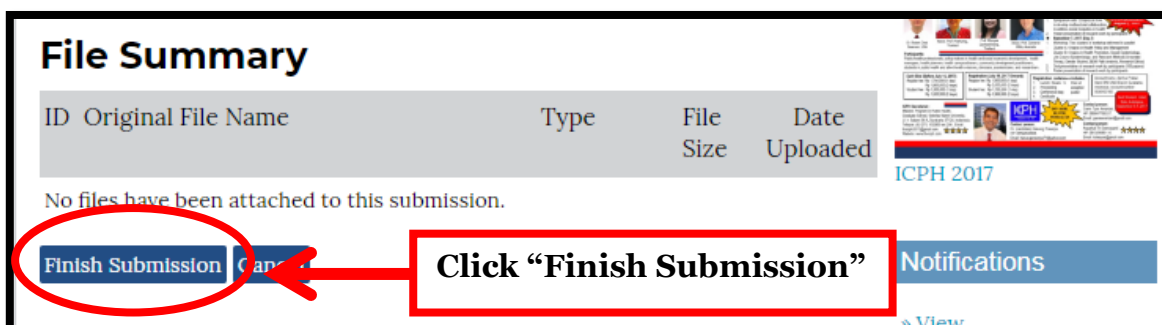
